## **Environmental Concerns**

- Both prescription and non-prescription drugs are being found in our rivers, streams and ground water.
- Our existing waste water treatment plants and septic systems are not designed to remove these contaminants.
- A certain amount of these contaminants can be reduced when the bins are used instead of flushing unwanted drugs down the toilet or putting them in the trash.

## **Public Safety Concerns**


- Nearly 7 million Americans are abusing controlled prescription drugs more than the number abusing cocaine, heroin, hallucinagens, Ecstasy and inhalents combined.\*
- Nearly 1 in 10 high school seniors admits to abusing prescription pain killers.\*
- Removing prescription painkillers from the medicine cabinet will help to reduce the chances of drug abuse and accidental missuse.
